

Notebooks are made for asking questiopns, making plans and exploring ideas. We use them to think becuase thinking is something we need to do - silly things can happen if we don't. There are many forms of thinking and some require a tactile space, a private space, a space for inpsiration.

We make books for those moments, for that process, for that journey.

We want our design and production to reflect our ideas about the world, one we think can be better.





& Overthinking

We think a lot about what we do and the wider impact of all making so we work locally, use recycled papers, use ink with restraint and use second hand ingrastructure where possible. We recycle our waste.

We want to develop print & design in the direction of circular economy thinking and similar degrowth ideas of repair, reuse and durability. Our design choices reflect our willingness to ask questions (it's not easy, there's a lot of contradicitions) and do things differently. We encourage you to do the same.

Not all our current ideas are working too well.



The way we think about notebooks can change too. The elasticated binding allows this design to layflat, to be refilled and offering open source interaction with the world of paper. Create a notebooks that works for you with a planner in the fornt and sketch paper in the back.







GOLD

We have been looking for the lowest impact form of printing since we made our first books. Gold embossing is a restrictive and manual process but its durable and low on consumables... & lovely.

We pair this process with papers that incorporate wool fibres, almond shells, coffee chaff & residue in their production. Run your hand across a wool-fiber page and feel its previous life emerging in texture and depth.


For custom orders (MOQ - 10), you have choices about impact as well as aesthetics. Gold foil catches attention but blind embossing - no foil, no heat - just the impression of words in paper offers something quietly luxurious & subtly sustainable.

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DRAWINGS

Hand drawn desgins reflect our ethos to use your hands, to embrace the tactile approach to creating.

These notebooks feature illustrations by Aisling Gaffney, her watercolours have been scanned and arranged by badly made books.

These use the same innovative Italian papers as our embossed collection, incorporating citrus and corn fibres. The natural texture of these materials adds depth to the printing, while their recycled origin aligns with our drive to minimize impact.

Working with digital printing, we've developed techniques to reduce ink consumption without compromising design integrity. It's a balance of presence and absence, where negative space is a positive choice.








LANDSCAPES

There's a peculiar poetry in printing landscapes onto notebooks - capturing views of nature on pages that might, in their making, affect those very views. We've wrestled with this irony, finding ways to use less ink, to create more spaces, to tread more lightly while still sharing these scenes.


These are our most popular notebooks, often chosen by those who've traveled far to see these landscapes firsthand. Perhaps in buying them, people don't just take home a memento, but a question: about distance, about impact, about how we hold onto places, we love them but we must ask ourselves how our love will impact them.

We don't have answers, but we keep asking, with every landscape we print.



Epilogue: On Cost and Consideration

Some costs show up on price tags. Others appear in rivers, in lungs, in futures we've borrowed from children not yet born.

When we chose to make notebooks here, to pay fair wages, to think longer about each choice, to work slower with considered hands, we chose which costs to carry.

Yes, these notebooks cost more than those made where workers earn less, where rivers pay the price, where speed matters more than thought, where questions go unasked.

But perhaps that's exactly the point: If we're going to think deeply about how the world could change, shouldn't we think deeply about how our tools for thinking are made?

These pages cost more because we believe thinking costs time questions cost courage and change costs something more than money can measure.

What we make here is space for thought, room for questions, and permission to consider everything that usually goes unconsidered.

Some might call this overthinking. We call it paying attention to what really costs, and who really pays, when we choose not to think about such things.
